TRACK RULES

ALDER STREET RACEWAY

- 1. NO food, beverages, or liquids on track surface.
- 2. NO traction compounds, or traction additives on tires.
- 3. RACE OFFICIAL'S decission is FINAL.
 - A. officials will be appointed before start of time trials. (minimum of 2).
 - B. officials will operate track power, and timing of races.
 - C. officials will enforce rules, and settle disagreements.
 - D. officials will signal a restart by shutting off track power. rules for restart...
 - 1. a race will be restarted if any of the following conditions arrise.
 - a. any one of the cars fail to leave the starting line.
 - b. if more than half the cars crash on the first lap.
 - c. a major dispute or disagreement over lap counting or timing of a race, left to the discretion of the track officials.
 - E. officials will black flag drivers for any of the following reasons...
 - a. car leaving moisture or liquid on track.
 - b. use of traction compound.
 - c. car body falling off or interfering with other cars.
 - d. car loosing parts or tires.
 - F. officials will tech inspect all cars prior to qualifing.
- 4. NO unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 5.NO car substitutions. After start of race driver must race car qualified

OPEN CLASS RULES

ALDER STREET RACEWAY

- 1. Maximum overall car width 1 3/8 inches.
- 2. Body must be securely mounted.
- 3. Body damage that occurs while racing must be repaired before starting next heat race.
- 4. No extra magnets added to car. Car must use same number of magnets as originally equiped.
- 5. No cobalt or rare earth type magnets.
- 6. Bodies must be completely painted. (as neatly as possible).
- 7. All cars must be numbered. Numbers must be clearly displayed.
- 8. Paint chips on car bodies must be repaired prior to the start of each race. (Day of racing).
- 9. No traction additives, or compounds.
