H.O.R.O. 1985 POINT SERIES CAR CLASSES

GROUP 1 -

This will be the main class of the 1985 Point Series. The Group 1 class will be run at each and every race of the 1985 Point Series.

- RULES Group 1 :
 - 1. Maximum overall car width shall not exceed 1 3/8 inches.
 - 2. Car body must be securely mounted.
 - 3. Body damage that occurs while racing must be repaired before starting next heat. (Any damage to body or its mounting system or the chassis itself, must be repaired if there is a possibility of the damaged car interfering with another cars operation)
 - No extra magnets added to car. Car must use same number of magnets as originally equipped.
 - 5. No Cobalt or Rare Earth type magnets.
 - 6. Car bodies must be completely painted. (As neatly and realistically as possible, Please).
 - 7. All cars must be numbered. Numbers must be clearly displayed.
 - Traction compounds will be used ONLY on tracks specifically allowing its use.
 - 9. Car must use a monolithic type chassis with an inline type armature. A monolithic type chassis being a production type plastic chassis with magnets installed in the chassis to gain magnetic adhesion to the track.

GROUPS 2,3,4 -

These three classes are alternate classes. One of these three classes will be run at each race of the 1985 Point Series.

RULES - Group 2 :

9. Car must use an Aurora Magna-Traction chassis.

RULES - Group 3 :

Rules | thru 8 listed under Group |.

9. Car must use an Aurora Thunderjet 500 chassis.

10. No magnetic adhesion to track.

RULES - Group 4 :

Rules 1,2,3,5,6,7,8 listed under Group 1. Any other modifications allowed - Group 4 open to all chassis designs and any modifications not restricted by rules 1,2,3,5,6,7,8 under Group 1.

Points from any and all of the classes run at an H.O.R.O. Point Series Race will be counted and applied to each driver's individual seasons total score. All classes are scored the same, using the same point system and point values. There will be a Point Series Champion Overall as well as a Point Series Class Champion in each class.

10. No car in any class shall be equipped with more than one guide pin or flag. Cars will use | guide pin or flag only.

Group 5 -

This class will replace the Group 4 class for the remainder of the 1985 season. Group 5 is an alternate class, voted in on Dec.16,1984.

Rules - Group 5 :

9. Car must use an Aurora Thunderjet 500 chassis.

10. No magnetic adhesion to track.

- 11. Car must use magnets made specifically for the Thunderjet chassis. Magna-Traction type taller magnets cannot be used After market high performance magnets can be used, as long as they are the short Thunderjet type magnets.
- 12. The Thunderjet 500 gear plate must be used.
- 13. Thunderjet 500 brass gears must be used in the gear plate.
- 14. Any style pick-up shoes may be used.
- 15. Any armature may be used as long as it is a pancake type armature. (Same armature basic design as Thunderjet).
- 16. Car must use original Thunderjet hard plastic body. Body may be trimmed or modified, but must retain the look of a full bodied race car. - Please!
